All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least one a year.

Days of Penance: *Under* **14**: No abstaining or fasting obliged.

14-17: Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday *No fasting obliged*. **18-59:** Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting obliged. **60+** No abstaining or fasting obliged, while maintaining the spirit of Lent
