All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least one a year.

Days of Penance: *Under 14*: No abstaining or fasting obliged. *14-17:* Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday *No fasting obliged. 18-59:* Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting obliged. *60+* No abstaining or fasting obliged, while maintaining the spirit of Lent
