WHERE IS BISHOP-ELECT BRIAN MASCORD FROM ?: He was born in Newcastle, NSW 30 January 1959.He achieved a Diploma of Teaching at the Catholic College of Education at Castle Hill, he continued his studies at St Patrick's College, Manly, Where he obtained a Bachelor of Theology, He was ordained a Priest on 31 October 1992 in Hamilton by Bishop Leo E Clark, and was incardinated in the Diocese of Maitland (later Maitland-Newcastle). From 1993 to 96, he worked as an assistant Priest and administrator in the parishes of Taree, Hamilton and Stockton. He then served as parish Priest at: Cardiff, East Maitland and Morpeth, Maitland, Lochinvar and Rutherford. Since 2007, he has been the vocations director. Moreover, he has been working as administrator for the parishes of Nelson Bay and also Mayfield and Mayfield West. He has been a long-standing member of the Council of Priests (2006 to present) and is currently a member of the diocesan Clergy Life and Ministry Team (2013-to present) and of the National Council for Clergy Life and Ministry (2015-present). Since 2012, Brian has been the vicar general of the Diocese of Maitland-Newcastle.
