

THE EPICSOPAL ORDINATION OF MOST REVEREND
BRIAN GREGORY MASCORD: Fifth Bishop of Wollongong,
7pm Thursday 22nd February at WIN Entertainment Centre,
Wollongong. It is anticipated that the ordination will be
celebrated by up to 4,500 people including approx. 30
Bishops (including the Papal Nuncio in Australia, His
Excellency Most Reverend Adolfo Tito Yllana), 100 Priests
and Deacons, parishioners and families from all our Parish
School, staff, diocesan agencies, and affiliated organisations,
leaders of other Churches and faiths, civic leaders of
government and business, media, their families, many of
Brian's family, friends, parishioners and community members
from the Diocese of Maitland-Newcastle.

The ordination is at WIN Entertainment Centre, because of the large number of people attending, "We can't take the people to the Cathedral, we will take the Cathedral to the people. Therefore, the backdrop for the ordination will be a recreation of the Cathedral stained glass windows and icons.
