

PARISH COLLECTIONS: The Parish Finance Council has decided to change the Order of the week-end collection at all Masses to comply with the Diocesan Regulations. So from next weekend, the FIRST COLLECTION (taken up at the Offertory of the Mass) will be Remuneration of the Priests of the Diocese, including the sick, Retired and aged Priests of the Diocese.

The **SECOND COLLECTION** (taken up after Holy Communion) is for the Parish expenses (electricity, repairs and maintenance, wages, insurance etc). This includes Parish Planned Giving Envelopes and all loose money in the Second Collection.

This will come into effect from next weekend, 20th - 21st May.
