THE EPICSOPAL ORDINATION OF MOST REVEREND BRIAN GREGORY MASCORD: Fifth Bishop of Wollongong, 7pm Thursday 22nd February at WIN Entertainment Centre. **Wollongong.** The previous Bishops of Wollongong were: Bishops Thomas Absolem McCabe (1951-1974), William Edward Murray (1975-1996), Philip Edward Wilson (1996-2000) and Peter William Ingham (2001-2017).

The Sacramental role of a Bishop is: like priests, celebrate the Eucharist, baptise, celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, unite couples in Marriages, and Anoint the Sick. Bishops confer the sacrament of Holy Orders and are able to ordain deacons, priests and bishops. Bishops are the original ministers of Confirmation, though priests may confirm when delegated or when liturgical law indicates. Only bishops consecrate Chrism, the Holy Oil used at Baptism, Confirmation and Ordinations.
