ADVENT 2018-2019: Next weekend we begin the Church's New Year with the First Sunday of Advent. **Readers** please note the Mass Readings for the New Church Year will be **Year C** in the Lectionary.

SAVIOUR: ADVENT PROGRAM 2018 BOOK: Is available for \$3.50 per copy from our Parish Piety Stall. It begins the 1st Week of Advent and concludes the Baptism of the Lord. Advent is such a busy time of year and we so easily forget that—at its heart—it is meant to be a time of preparation, waiting and hope for the coming of Jesus into our world and lives. This year's reflection book, Saviour, provides an opportunity for us to be still each day, listen to God and hear him declare to us as the angel declared to the shepherds: "Today in the town of David a Saviour has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:11). **Saviour** is a 76 page pocket-size book containing short spiritually rich, yet accessible, daily reflections from the beginning of Advent (2 December 2018) through to the Baptism of the Lord (13 January 2019) primarily for personal use, but also appropriate for group use such as parish, Church agency, religious community and school staff/class prayer.
