

#### St. Thomas More Primary School 40th Anniversary Ouilt:

This year is the St. Thomas More Primary School's  $40^{\rm th}$  Anniversary. To commemorate this occasion we are looking to create a St. Thomas More family quilt, made up of squares from each family in our school, both past and present.

Families, who would like to participate, will be given a fabric square to create an image to represent their family as part of the St. Thomas More family.

We are hoping you will include your family name and/or the names of each child in your family who has attended St. Thomas More. The square could also contain an image or symbol to represent your family and your journey at St. Thomas More. It is up to you.

You could use: embroidery, quilting, patchwork or whatever other medium you choose.

You can do it yourself or have someone do it for you. The only request will be that the entire piece is created using school colours: gold, royal blue, white or grey. School uniform fabric can also be used. This will help keep the quilt uniform and tie it altogether.
