

ST VINCENT DE PAUL – WINTER APPEAL: Your St Vincent de Paul Conference is conducting a Winter Appeal in the Parish until 16th/17th June.

The Conference is not in urgent need of cash this year but for Parishioners who find cash donations more convenient, there will be envelopes at the back of the Church for the remainder of the Appeal. Simply complete and place the envelope in either the 1st or 2nd collection. Any cash received will be put towards buying food or resources for the Nagle Centre. This year our main focus is food for the Nagle Centre, where homeless, hungry and lonely people of our area go to receive filling meals. It is a service that is vital to our community and your support is needed.

Nagle have specifically requested; Tinned tuna, tinned spaghetti, baked beans, soup, tinned fruit as well as milk powder, long life full cream milk, custard powder, hot chocolate, tea, coffee, cordial, pasta sauce, tomato paste, 2-minute noodles. Non-food items needed are nappies, wet wipes for babies, beanies, scarves and gloves.

Please note that this year Nagle do not require blankets, socks, flour, rice or pasta as we they have a good supply of all of those items and storage is an issue.

There are baskets at the back of the church for each weekend of the Appeal, where you may place non-cash donations. Please think of the above items when next out shopping remembering the words of Sr Rosalie Rendu; "Be kind and love, for love is your first gift to the poor"
