- Fr Tony Daly was diagnosed with end-stage liver and pancreatic cancer on Monday 15th February. He was immediately admitted to hospital and remains hospitalised.
- Fr Tony has remained in good spirits and has had most of his family visiting him from rural areas and interstate.
- Fr Tony has unfortunately deteriorated since his diagnosis, requiring more nursing care. Fr Tony has assistance from Palliative Care Staff.
- Due to Fr Tony's increased care needs, we ask that *only family* visit him. Perhaps writing Fr Tony a brief letter or card advising him that you are thinking of him and praying for him, would be a great encouragement. Fr Tony celebrates the 13th Anniversary of his Ordination to the Priesthood today (Saturday). He was ordained on 27 February 2003.
