- 1. Make the **Sign of the Cross** and say the <u>"Apostles' Creed."</u>
- 2. Say the <u>"Our Father."</u>
- 3. Say three <u>"Hail Marys."</u>
- 4. Say the <u>"Glory be to the Father."</u>
- 5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the <u>"Our Father."</u>
- 6. Say ten <u>"Hail Marys,"</u> while meditating on the Mystery.
- 7. Say the <u>"Glory be to the Father."</u>
- 8. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the <u>"Our Father."</u> Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.

Saying this great prayer the family Rosary every day will always bring peace in the family – The family that prays together stays together.
