As part of the Year of Grace, the Church in Australia has organised a pilgrimage of a relic of Saint Francis Xavier throughout Australia. The pilgrimage aims to help us contemplate and imitate Christ by contemplating the life of Saint Francis Xavier, one of the foremost Church missionaries and evangelisers and a significant exemplar of the imitation of Christ. STEWARDSHIP

24th Sunday Ordinary Time

In the second reading today, St James has harsh words for those who do not put their faith into action. Indeed, the Gospel message impels us to 'lay down our life' for the sake of the Kingdom. Sharing in Jesus' mission we too are called to put our faith into action, taking up our cross and following him, putting our faith into practice.

The *Mass* is made up as it were of two parts: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. These two parts are so closely interconnected that they form but one single act of worship. For in the Mass the table both of God's word and of Christ's Body is laid, from which the faithful may be instructed and refreshed. GIRM 26

All must *Listen with reverence* to the reading of God's word, for they make up an element of greatest importance in the Liturgy. Although in the readings from the Sacred Scripture God's word addresses all people of every era and is understand-able to them, nevertheless, a living commentary on the word, that is, the *Homily*, as part of the liturgical action, fosters a fuller understanding and effectiveness of the word. *GIRM* 29
