HOUR OF PRAYER AND STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Will be

every Friday during Lent beginning with the Hour of Prayer at 6.30pm followed by Stations of the Cross at 7.30pm in the Church.

Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed their 18th year, until The beginning of their 60th year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their 14th year (CCL97, 1251f)

Lent is a penitential season of prayer, self-denial and helping others. In this way, the whole Church prepares for Easter with those who are to be baptised.
