MASS ATTENDANCE:

As you are aware the Mass times for Sunday: Vigil - Saturday at 6.00pm and Sunday - at 9.00am.

Mass starts promptly at these times. To fulfill your obligation you need to be in attendance at the beginning of the Mass and the Final Blessing.

It is very distracting to those who are already in the Church to have people coming in late.

The Mass begins with the sign of the Cross and Welcome, which then leads to the Penitential Rite, the Liturgy of the Word (Readings) and the Gospel.

We then move to the Profession of Faith and Prayers of Intercession. This then prepares us for Celebrating the Eucharist (that is the receiving of the Body and Blood of Christ) and ending with the final prayer and Blessing.

To fulfill your obligation of Mass attendance you need to be present for all of the parts of the Mass.

Talk to God before Mass, let God talk to you during Mass and talk to each other after Mass.
