Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Church because the day celebrates when God's people were empowered by the Holy Spirit to take the 'baton' passed on by Jesus to his followers. Pentecost is the day that the church was born. Christ was crucified, rose again, spent forty days with his disciples, then ascended to heaven. Pentecost immediately followed.

Pentecost takes place 50 days after Easter Sunday.
