


PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS

Drinking from the chalice is the preferred method of receiving the Blood of Christ because of the Lord's command: *Take and drink*. If intinction is used, it is the minister who dips the host in the chalice and places it in the communicant's mouth.
